# YOUR CHALLENGE

5. What type of platform should the student rewards be built upon? ie: web-based, mobile, etc.

## HOW CAN YOU SCORE SOME **BIG** POINTS?

### **Effort & WOW Factor**

Think outside the box when creating your video. Feel free to use still images, audio, music, or any other video techniques to convey your idea(s).

### **Unique-ness & Creativity**

Is there something out there already like it, or is your idea the first of its kind?

### **Clarity & Organization**

Is it easy to understand how your idea provides a benefit to the intended user?

### **Quality of Submission**

Entries that have poor audio quality or low screen resolution will be docked points. There is no requirement around minimum or maximum length for your video. It should be long enough to get your ideas across without losing your viewers interest.

### You can submit your video one of two ways:

1. Upload it onto a memory stick and drop off at any Prairie Centre branch. Ensure it's placed in a sealed envelope labeled "Attention: Marketing", and include your return address so we can get your memory stick back to you!
2. Upload your video to YouTube. It can be a Public or Unlisted video. Email your video link to: **Achieve@pccu.ca**

# CRITERIA

ACH!EVE is open to all Grade 12 students in one of the following schools who are pursuing any type of post-secondary education for a minimum of one year full-time studies (proof of enrollment will be required).

Students must achieve a 70% minimum for \$3,500 scholarships.

Students must achieve a minimum of 50% to qualify for runner-up scholarships of \$500. If minimum marks are not achieved, the scholarship money will be allocated towards education and / or youth initiatives in the Prairie Centre trading area within the calendar year.

Student submissions will be viewed by a panel where they will be scored. Submissions must receive a minimum score to be eligible for a scholarship. If no one from your school sends in a submission or the minimum score is not met on any entries, no scholarship will be awarded. All submissions may be used in part, or in whole, for marketing purposes. Student will be given full recognition if their work is used.
